RULES & REGULATIONS: The following classes must meet individual regulations: Touring, Fulldressers, all bike, saddlebags, side cars, farings and trailers; Antique: produced between 1899-1929 inclusive, 1930 inclusive to 1945, 1946-1954 Postwar; Classic & Special Interest, 1955-up; Conservative Street, none-7 changes, all bolt-on parts constitutes a change, paint, seat, exhaust, chrome; Custom Street, 8-15 changes; Full Custom, anything fully customized with no frame alterations; Radical, changes over 15 includes after market frame, or altered frame and engine. Classes can be changed at the judges' discretion. Bikes must start and stop on their own power. Display bikes must supply their own set-ups. Protest fee \$25.00. NOTE: For those travelling over 80 miles one way, tow money after first 50 miles each way 10 cents a mile per bike, 15 cents a mile for bike w/sidecar, or free hotel.
